Application and dosage

- Apply a thin layer on thoroughly cleaned, neutralized and dry floor covering with a mop or a scrubber. Let it dry thoroughly and repeat the process. Perform the last application with a colourless coating, S 734, S 737, S 741. For sealing, choose between Corridor® Glorin S 734 for glossy, Corridor® Matt S 737 for matte or Corridor® Jewel S 741 for high-gloss.
- Consumption: 25 - 35 ml / per m² / per order

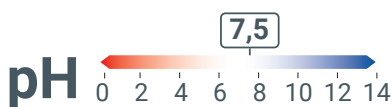
- Protect from frost. Before processing, turn off heat sources (underfloor heating, heating, hot supply air).
